They have also supported local schools over the years by offering work experience and interview rehearsals for Year 11 and 12 students,


and tours of home builds to Pathway to Construction students.

They hired a receptionist/ accounts person to be at the office while Don juggled appointments with clients and supervised projects while

in the day to day on-site.

"As we became more ley looks back on how far the known in the community and attracted more work, we outgrew our premises," Don's wife, and Bailey Homes co-owner, Carolyn Bailey said.

"When a home came up sole trader business became for sale in Victoria Street in 1995, Don saw the potential of turning it into offices."

"After updating the inside and adding a porch and carpark Bailey Homes moved into its current location at 58 Victoria Street, Victor Harbor."

"A few years later a board room was added and a selection area and in 2012 the entire office underwent a major renovation while still operating. We now had proper street frontage, large reception area, larger boardroom and selection area, more offices and toilets along with more parking."

"Our grand opening took place on 14/11/2012 with members of parliament and other dignitaries present."

Along with lifting their

external appearance in 2021, a lot of changes were happening behind the scenes, as re-prioritising and changing the vision of Bailey Homes was being developed.

"We re-branded Bailey Homes with a new logo and slogan 'Your Vision, Our Passion'," office manager, Jessica Clapp said.

"What started as a company striving to be competitive in an ever-expanding market where our quality set us apart, developed into a Bailey Homes that knew our place in the industry and decided to embrace it and focus on the niche market of custom-built homes; prioritising the individuality of every client, every home and every journey."

"We changed our focus and directed it to meet our passion of delivering quality, dream homes to our clients."

"Homes that are customised to each of their desires and meeting the ever-developing sustainable approach to building that is so important to both us and our clients."







Don is proud to be a local builder that endeavours to use as many quality locals as possible.


